a. 2026 LMIG: Acceptance of bid for resurfacing of Brooker St and Roosevelt Street.

City Manager Wirth informed the Mayor and Council the lowest bid price was from Georgia Asphalt of \$56,786.29. Mayor Pro-Tem Davis made the motion to approve the bid from Georgia Asphalt and move forward with the project. Councilmember Johns seconded the motion, all in favor, motion carried by 3-0 vote. b. 2026 Legal Organ
